Purpose: The purpose of this 2-day class is to improve the female officer's rifle shooting overall performance. Through intensive range work the female rifle operator will increase her ability to deliver her weapon system efficiently and effectively particularly in marksmanship. Performance based focus areas include: Sniper accuracy 50 yrds and in, weapon retention and manipulation for smaller statured officers, shooting with movement, individual and team competitions.



Requirements: Attendees are required to bring a patrol style rifle, three magazines, 400 rounds of rifle ammo, *high power binoculars* or *spotting scope*, 50 rounds of pistol ammunition, brimmed hat, wrap-around eye protection, ear protection, pistol with three magazines, elbow and knee pads recommended. ***A water source and simple carbohydrate is highly recommended.
