Cynthia Williams

Cynthia has been a law enforcement officer since 2000 and is currently the Training Sergeant for the Palm Bay Police Department in Florida. In her career Cynthia has served in the following capacities: Field Training Officer, Narcotics Agent, Patrol Supervisor and SWAT team member. Cynthia began her SWAT career in 2003 at the Key West Police Department in Florida.

Cynthia is a highly decorated officer and has been the recipient of many recognitions and commendation awards for her performance. In 2004, Cynthia became a high liability instructor. She is currently an adjunct instructor with Brevard Community College Institute of Criminal Justice. Cynthia is a certified DT Instructor; Firearms Instructor; Taser Instructor; CPR/First Aid Instructor; Simunition Safety Instructor; and Distraction Device Instructor. Cynthia oversees the Training Unit for the Palm Bay Police Department and is responsible for all departmental training for sworn and non-sworn personnel, which consists of approximately 166 sworn and 80 non-sworn co-workers.

Cynthia attended St. Thomas University in Miami, Florida on an athletic scholarship for soccer. She played goalkeeper for the University. At the end of 3 years she obtained a BA in Criminal Justice from St. Thomas University. She currently attends American Military University where she is working to complete her Master's Degree in Homeland Security.

As a teenager, Cynthia trained in Tae Kwon Do and currently trains in Brazilian Jujitsu under Instructor Edgard Dutra and is a member of Brazilian Top Team. Cynthia has competed in the North American Grappling Association, as well as the Florida Law Games. She has earned first place honors in both gi and no-gi submission grappling. (When

she is not competing she enjoys working with her favorite student, her son Isaac) Cynthia is also an amateur body builder, and has competed in 3 National Physique Committee competitions. She has won first place in her categories. Additionally, she holds a certification in Sports Nutrition and Physical Fitness.
