Purpose: The purpose of this class is to improve shooting performance as it relates to surviving a lethal encounter. Performance based focus areas include: Problem solving, single hand and support hand shooting, expeditious stoppage clearing and reloading under time constraints, and target-focused

shooting.

Requirements: Attendees are required to bring 200-250 rounds of standard pistol ammunition, brimmed hat, wrap-around eye protection, ear protection, pistol with three magazines. ***A water source and simple carbohydrate is highly recommended.
